In 2020 we created even more space to children and young people. Space to play. Space to grow. Space to make friends. Space to improve physical and mental health. With these words we closed last year, on the threshold of the global corona crisis. It was a year full of serious challenges.

Despite all global restrictions, we have managed to provide space for the children and young people who need it most. We want to highlight one of Johan Cruyff's favourite quotes: "Every disadvantage has its advantage". The corona crisis has challenged us. And thanks to the tenacious effort of the team, the loyal support of our ambassadors and volunteers, professional cooperation with organizations and institutions, and constructive partnerships, we have been able to reach children and young people during this very difficult year.

The Cruyff Foundation has offices in the Netherlands and Spain. Internationally, we become more and more important. In our work we felt the effects of the pandemic. In the Netherlands, in Spain and in the rest of the world.

The 20th edition of the Open Day in the Netherlands was unforgettable in every way. Due to the strict measures, children could not come to the Olympic Stadium in Amsterdam, so we opted to go to the children together with some of our ambassadors. A fantastic day. In Spain, the situation was more complicated and the

restrictions were more severe, so the Open Day could not be held.

In South Africa, Malaysia and the United Kingdom, all Cruyff Courts had to close. LaLeague's soccer program was postponed in both Brazil and Nicaragua. Some of the activities were done online. Fundraising continued to be a big challenge. We said: if it cannot be done as it should, then it must be done as it can.

Vulnerable children and young people have actually had fewer opportunities during the pandemic. This is worrisome and touches our hearts. Not having enough space means that they hardly exercise. That's why it's important to give them a positive boost, especially now.

The Johan Cruyff Foundation is committed to creating space for children and young people to exercise and play sports. Almost 5 years ago we began to structurally measure and professionally map the global impact of the Johan Cruyff Foundation, confirming that the growing impact of our work is undeniable.

We are proud of our contribution to society, together with cooperation partners, organizations, institutions, companies, municipalities and all other stakeholders. Once again, we want to thank them for all their support.

As Johan once wonderfully said: "Alone we can't do it, we have to do it together". His vision is and continues to be our driving force. Together, we continue what Johan Cruyff started.

Heroes of the Cruyff Courts


